

# PRAYER CALENDAR

## **NOVEMBER**

#### Morocco

#### November 1

Pray for Christians in Marrakech who lost loved ones and their homes in September's devastating earthquake. Pray for divine strength, comfort and peace in the days ahead.

#### November 2

There is a small but hidden church in Morocco. Pray for believers who are ministering to victims, that their witness might shine in the darkness and bring many to Christ.

#### **November 3**

Believers ask for prayer as they struggle through the devastation—while seeking to serve their communities with the love of Jesus.

#### November 4

Father, I ask you to be with those who are hurting and restore what was lost. I pray that my Moroccan family would see your hand both in and over their lives.

### Malaysia

#### **November 5**

Malay Christians ask us to pray for their newly elected state leaders. Pray they will govern with integrity and work to foster religious freedom.

#### November 6

Pray today for the court hearing surrounding Pastor Raymond Koh's February 2017 abduction. His son, Jonathan, asks: "Please continue to uphold us."

#### **November 7**

Pray for our partners' youth hostel program, created to help Christian students strengthen their identity in Christ. Pray it impacts many young people.

#### **November 8**

Pray for these students as they build Christ-centered friendships that remind them they're not alone in their journey.

#### **November 9**

Pray for the workshop leaders. Ask God to give them both insight and the words to reach these students.

### Indonesia

#### **November 10**

In Indonesia, some Muslim parents teach their children to hate Christians. Pray that Christian parents can help kids stay grounded in their faith.

#### **November 11**

Pray for those children who grow up hating Christians, that they will experience the love of Jesus through the very people they are taught to despise.

#### **November 12**

Pray for strength for 6-year-old Adi who's bullied by neighborhood kids. "They told me, 'Let's stay away from this Christian. Bye-bye, Christian kid."

#### **November 13**

Pray for new believers like Hasan\* who can't find a church that accepts them. Many churches are afraid of being accused of converting people.

#### **November 14**

Praise God for a recent retreat where Hasan met other Christians who left Islam to follow Jesus. For the first time, he says, he does not feel alone and discouraged in his faith.

#### **November 15**

Pray that God will bring more believers like Hasan to Open Doors retreats where they can find community, read God's Word and grow in their faith.

#### Central Asia

#### **November 16**

Pray for Murat and Mira who lead a secret house church (we can't name the country for their protection). Open Doors supported them through micro-loans to open a shop.

Elnura\*, young girl who is supported by Open Doors' work among deaf Christians in Central Asia.



#### **November 17**

Pray their shop will flourish, as they help other believers by giving them jobs in it.

#### **November 18**

Praise God for a successful Open Doors-supported Bible study seminar where five students delved deep into Scripture.

#### **November 19**

Pray for Andrew, one of the participants. As a pastor, he must be diligent about protecting his church while encouraging them in their faith.

#### **November 20**

Pray for Asel\* whose family kicked her out of their house when they discovered she was a Christian.

#### **November 21**

Pray that Asel would find permanent housing (she is currently staying in her local house church).

#### November 22

Pray for her emotional health. She is feeling discouraged. Pray also that her family would accept her faith.

## Bangladesh

#### **November 23**

Pray for the attendees of three persecution preparedness trainings, that what they learned would take root.

#### **November 24**

Pray for the facilitators as they prepare to lead more sessions and make their way to the various locations.

#### November 25

Pray for local church leaders, that they would encourage their churches to attend these trainings.

#### **November 26**

Pray for protection during the trainings. Ask God to confuse the plans of those who might want to disrupt the meetings (Psalm 55:19).

#### November 27

Pray these sessions will strengthen and equip believers to serve their local churches.

#### North Korea

#### November 28

Due to COVID 19, our secret route to distribute listening devices and essentials for North Korean believers became limited. Pray that God will make a new way.

#### November 29

Yoon-Seo\* is a member of an Open Doors' safe house in a neighboring country. But her family lives in North Korea. She asks us to pray for her parents' health.

#### **November 30**

Recently she found out her brother broke his arm, and the medical service fee is too much. Pray for healing and provision to pay his expenses.

## **DECEMBER**

#### Iran

#### **December 1**

As Christmas approaches, pray for protection for Iranian house churches. The government often cracks down on Christians during this time.

#### December 2

Pray for families whose loved ones are imprisoned for their faith. Father, surround these families with your peace—give them signs of your hope.



#### **December 3**

Darya\* is a house church leader. Pray for protection and discernment for leaders like her, that this month, they would be even more vigilant in their actions.

#### **December 4**

Praise God for the release of Joseph Shahbazian from Tehran's Evin Prison, jailed for his faith in Christ! Our family in Iran asks us to pray for his recovery and protection.

#### **December 5**

Shahin and her husband want to adopt a child but Iran's laws prohibit non-Muslims from adopting. "I will tell the truth, I'm a Christian," she says, "please pray God would help us and add a new member to our family."

#### Brunei

#### December 6

Pray for provision for Bruneians who feel pressured to convert to Islam. Muslims receive more financial support than people from other religions, and the cost of following Jesus is real.

#### **December 7**

Please pray for this situation, where economic inequality has pushed people to do whatever they can to survive.

#### **December 8**

Pray for strength and resilience for Christians in Brunei. May they feel God's presence and His allconsuming love for them.

#### **December 9**

Sexual abuse is a growing concern. Pray for young women exploited by family members. Ask God to give them the strength to report this abuse.

#### **December 10**

Pray the authorities will not ignore these reports and will work to bring justice and prevent these incidents, and stop this heinous trend.

#### **December 11**

Pray for traumatized victims. Ask God to be everclose to them and to place people in their path who will support them.

#### **December 12**

Pray that families will be vigilant and create a safe space for their young ones.

#### | Sri Lanka

#### **December 13**

Pray for Shehan\*, an 80-year-old believer in the Trincomalee district. He is isolated from his family because of his faith in Jesus.

#### **December 14**

Pray for provision. His family doesn't look after him. Shehan lives in a rural village and must hunt animals to eat.

#### **December 15**

Pray that God would encourage Shehan's faith. The long journey from his home to the church makes it difficult for him to attend.

#### **December 16**

Pray for Shehan's resilience. Despite his circumstances, he stands firm. Pray he will continue to hold on to Jesus.

#### **December 17**

Shehan asks us to pray for his family, that their hearts will be changed to see the love of Christ for them.

#### **December 18**

Last year, drug-related arrests increased by 39% in Sri Lanka. Pray for church leaders who say they find it more challenging to reach youth.

#### **December 19**

Pray that more young people will come to the Lord and be empowered to resist using drugs. Sri Lanka's youth need our prayers.

#### December 20

Pray for those suffering from addictions, that they would find the help they so desperately need.

## Myanmar

#### **December 21**

The family of one of our local partners, Brother Sam\*, is battling serious illnesses. Pray for healing.

#### **December 22**

Pray for access to treatments and medicines. And pray for strength and protection of his family's caregivers.

#### December 23

Pray for Myanmar believers who attended persecution preparedness trainings. Pray they would be emboldened to stand strong in their faith.

#### **December 24**

Pray that participants would be both encouraged and empowered by what they learned and understand that they are not alone.

#### **December 25**

Praise God for the birth of His Son! Pray for our persecuted family around the world as they follow Jesus no matter what.

#### Turkmenistan

#### **December 26**

Please pray for the churches in Turkmenistan where Christians make up only 1.1% of the population. Pray for resilience and boldness.

#### **December 27**

Pray for unity. The small Christian community in Turkmenistan is weak due to divisions between various denominations.

#### **December 28**

Pray for peace among church leaders. A Central Asia partner shared: "What the church really needs right now is to be one. And it must start with the leaders."

## **Armenia and Azerbaijan**

#### **December 29**

The hatred between these warring countries is so strong it has also impacted believers. Pray that God would bring His peace and healing.

#### **December 30**

Pray for the small communities of believers in Azerbaijan and Armenia, that they will continue to share Christ with their Muslim neighbors.

#### **December 31**

Pray for the few Kurdish believers—pray they will share Christ within their Kurdish communities.
